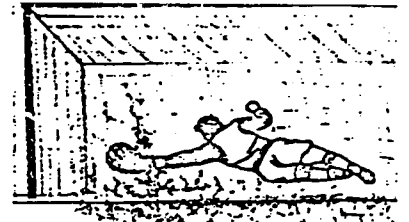

- WHY - (1) Soccer football has world-wide recognition as the number one game for building up stamina in youth, this thereby, also co-incides with the President's Council on Physical Fitness Program.
- (2) Soccer is the "average-sized" man's game - five feet nine inches & one hundred & sixty pounds - & therefore, every boy joining will play on a team & will not be eliminated at a later date because of his size or stature. In fact, all boys will play at least one third of each game that they participate in - that is twenty minutes.
- (3) Our program is patterned after the recent successful Olympic swimming team & therefore, we hope to place many boys on future Olympic soccer squads.
- (4) Soccer football has the highest paid athletes in the WORLD & therefore, rigid & constant participation in this program can develop boys into future professional soccer players commanding fabulous bonus fees & salaries.
- (5) Starting with the summer of 1968, after our boys have played for three years, we intend to visit foreign countries with our championship teams - soccer football is the NATIONAL sport of one hundred & forty-eight countries.

WHEN - Training & regularly scheduled league games will be played every Saturday afternoon from 2.00 to 4.00 p.m., through March 31st., 1966.

WHERE - Griffith Park Playground - Los Feliz Blvd. & Riverside Drive.
